

A waiver of admission fees to the museums of PIOP's Network is applicable for the following categories of citizens:

- Pupils of all levels of education.
- Young people of under 18, upon presentation of their national identity card.
- Students of universities, technical institutes or equivalent educational establishments of European Union countries, upon presentation of their student card.
- Students of the classics or of the arts from countries outside the E.U., upon presentation of their student card. Other students from countries outside the European Union pay the concessionary admission fee.
- Senior citizens (over 65), upon presentation of their national identity card.
- The parents of large families (four children and more).
- Disabled people
- Those called up for military service, upon presentation of their military ID card.
- The employees of the Hellenic Ministry of Culture and the Archaeological Receipts Fund, upon presentation of their service card.
- Holders of the special I.C.O.M. and I.C.O.M.O.S. member card, upon its presentation.
- Holders of the European Youth Card, upon its presentation.
- Tourist guides upon presentation of their N.G.T.O. card, as well as the drivers of tour coaches.
- Journalists, upon presentation of their press card delivered by the Greek Journalists' Union.
- Holders of the free entrance card delivered by the Hellenic Ministry of Culture.
- Academicians, teaching personnel of all three levels of education, as well as the archaeology and history graduates of Literature Faculties.

- The inhabitants and those originating from the village in which the museum is situated (N.B.: this measure does not apply to the inhabitants of towns and cities, as the data cannot be checked out).
- The members of Associations - Friends of the museums.
- Under certain circumstances, free admission to the museum is also allowed following a prior arrangement with PIOP (conference in the museum's premises, local authorities' VIP guests, foreign dignitaries, etc.)
