Free admission for the following categories of visitors, on presenting the relevant valid ID proof:

- 1. All visitors (Greek and foreign) under 18 years of age, on presenting ID Card or Passport confirming their age.
- 2. Students at night schools or second opportunity schools.
- 3. Students at Greek universities, technical universities, or equivalent institutions in EU countries, on presenting their student card.
- 4. Those doing their military service, on presenting their military ID Card.
- 5. Ministry of Culture employees, on presenting their service ID Card.
- 6. Academics and teachers of all levels of education.
- 7. Tourist guides, on presenting their professional ID Card.
- 8. Journalists, with current journalists' identification Card.
- 9. Members of the International Council of Museums (ICOM) or the International Council on Monuments and Sites (ICOMOS), on presenting valid membership card.
- 10. Members of Associations and Clubs of Friends of Museums and Archaeological Sites from anywhere in Greece, on presenting valid membership card.
- 11. Holders of free entrance Cards, on presenting valid card.
- 12. Holders of the European Youth Card, on presenting valid card.
- 13. Disabled people and their helper.
- 14. Members of families with many children, on presenting valid card. Members of three-child families, upon presentation of family situation certificate issued by the Municipality.
- 15. The unemployed, on presenting valid unemployment card.
- 16. Members of the Chamber of Fine Arts of Greece, on presenting their membership card.
- 17. Active and retired teachers of primary, secondary and tertiary education.
- 18. Greek single parent families with children up to the age of 25 and irrespective of age if they have disabilities, upon presentation of their ID card and a valid family status certificate issued by the Municipality and the Disability Certificate (issued by the Disability Certification Center).
